Sub: TNTEU – Colleges of Education affiliated to the University – Repeated  
complaints on functioning of the Colleges – Instructions issued to avoid  
such complaints in future – Reg.

I am, by direction to state that as per the provisions of NCTE Regulations, all the Colleges of Education affiliated to the University are being administered by the Trusts formed under the non-profit motives. Hence, the Colleges of Education shall function for the welfare of the students and under any circumstances, Colleges of Education should not take any coercive actions against the students studying in their Colleges of Education.

On the contrary, the University is receiving a large number of complaints from the students, their parents and general public against some Colleges of Education requesting the University to take appropriate action against such Colleges of Education and render justice to them. The abstracts of the various allegations made in the complaints are listed below.

- The Management/Principals collect higher fees than the fee fixed by the Government/University.
- The Institutions/Principals compel the SC/ST students to pay the tuition fees in advance.
- The Management/Principals refuse to return the original certificates (Mark statements, conduct certificate, community certificate etc.) to the student concerned.
- The Management/Principals use un-parliamentary words against the students and threaten them with dire consequences.

All the allegations listed above directly affect the student community if they are true which need immediate action. Hence, the following guidelines are issued to the Management/Principals of all the Colleges of Education affiliated to the University for strict implementation in their institutions.

1. The Institutions/Principals should not collect tuition fee in excess of the amount fixed by the Government, and similarly examination fees fixed by the University shall alone be collected.
2. The Institutions/Principals ought not to compel the SC/ST students to pay the tuition fees under no circumstances, since they are fully eligible for reimbursement from Government as post matric scholarship. (as per G.O.Ms.No.92, A&TW Dept., dated 11.09.2012)
3. The original certificates of individual students are their personal belongings, and hence all the original certificates should be returned to them, when they demand. The Management of the Institution has no right at all to withhold/refuse to return their original certificates.
4. The B.Ed/M.Ed students should be treated with utmost respect and dignity because they are going to be a role model for school children.
5. The copy of this communication should be put up on the college Notice Board for the entire academic year, in the visibility of students and parents.

The Management/Principals of all the Colleges of Education are hereby strictly instructed to follow the above five guidelines scrupulously, failing which severe action will be initiated against such erring Colleges of Education.
