I am by direction to inform you that the Government of Tamil Nadu in letter under reference have forwarded letter received from the Joint Secretary, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India and Judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 8th May 2009 in Civil Petition No.887 of 2009 wherein the Hon'ble Supreme Court has issued directions prohibiting ragging in Education Institutions.

The directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court were sent to your college in this office letter 2nd cited.

Further, the Principal Secretary to Governor, Raj Bhavan in his letter under 3rd cited, has requested to urge the Principals of the Colleges to consider participating in the programme "Declare your college Ragging Free" by adopting the following process.

1. The first step is that a student goes to the website of Aman Movement and presses the button – Declare Your College Ragging Free.
2. The second step is to fill in the details and a vote will be generated that will be sent to the students Email address automatically.
3. The third step is that the student will print the vote from his E-mail address and submit it to the Principal.
